

For most people, under most conditions, the under suit / base layer combinations mentioned above will be perfect. However, new techniques and re-breathers are enabling divers to push their dive times way beyond what was once the norm.

Internal thermal insulation for dry suits, we feel, is one of the most misunderstood elements of dry suit diving. It is fundamental for divers to understand thermal layering, its buoyancy implications, the impact on how your dry suit will fit and how that could hinder your movement.

If you get it wrong, it could lead to a whole bunch of issues that could take you down a path that will incur unnecessary cost and will make your diving less enjoyable.

If you get it right, it could enhance your whole dry suit diving experience.

If more insulation is required, think thin, breathable and add to your existing undersuit.
